Additionally, the PI has started the process of interviewing co-op undergraduate students who will work full-time in the PI's research group from six months from April through September, and will work part-time on this AQRP project. For task 2 "Laboratory preparation", small supplies needed to prepare one of the PI's CAPS sensors for use in measuring organic nitrates by thermal dissociation have been acquired (not with AQRP funds). As preparation for Task 3 "Field deployment", we have had phone conversations with collaborators from Aerodyne Research about the Aerodyne lab payload and measurement locations.
